The best-tasting drinking water from a Public Water System will represent all of New Mexico's rural water systems in a nationwide competition in Washington, DC at the annual Rural Water Rally event.

It all starts during NMRWA's Annual Conference. A panel of three judges will conduct a preliminary taste test on coded water samples to select the top five entries. The final "Taste Off" will take place during the President's Reception on Tuesday evening.

The Grand Prize Winner will receive \$1,500 towards airfare and hotel accommodations, **courtesy of Bohannan-Huston, Inc.**, to travel to Washington, DC to participate in the National Rural Water Association's **Great American Water Taste Test**. As the state's winner, you will meet with New Mexico's Congressional Delegation and have an opportunity to tour our nation's beautiful capitol city.

In addition, on Monday, April 5 from 12:30 to 3:00pm, conference goers will have the opportunity to taste entries and vote for the best tasting tap water in New Mexico. The winner of this competition will receive the newly created **People's Choice** award.

**This year NMRWA will be supplying quart-size glass containers and these are available at the NMRWA office or upon request from field circuit riders.**

Like fine wine, your water will be judged on taste, bouquet, and clarity. The rules are simple and entry is free...

- ❖ Bring "chilled" tap water in a non-returnable quart glass container to the conference registration area before 12 Noon on Monday, April 5
- ❖ Label the bottom of the container with your System Name
- ❖ Systems with populations over 25,000 are not eligible
- ❖ Systems must be in good standing with the NM Drinking Water Bureau - no current bacteriological or chemical monitoring violations
